

Mano Frey Labor Leadership Scholarship

Guidelines

The Mano Frey Scholarship has been established to honor a current and life-long devotee to organized labor. Junior and senior college students formally admitted into the degree-seeking programs of Labor Law, Construction Management, Engineering, Safety, Political Science, or similar degree programs are encouraged to apply.

This scholarship offers financial assistance for tuition and other educational expenses. This self-perpetuating annual scholarship was made possible by members of the Laborers International Union of North America Local 341, Anchorage, Alaska. Funds are awarded throughout the academic year. Award amount is \$5,000 per academic year, split between semesters.

Qualifications

1. Applicants must complete and submit their application to the office of Laborers' Local 341 no later than August 1 of the requested year.
2. Applicant should demonstrate motivation, academic and leadership potential
3. Applicants must have an accumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.25 or higher
4. Applicant must be in junior or senior status and admitted into an undergraduate major, or graduate program
5. Applicant must be an Alaskan resident
6. Preference will be given to members or the depended of a member in good standing with Laborers' Local 341

Forfeiture of Award

1. Does not enroll full-time in the semester in which the award is to be effective
2. Is placed on academic or disciplinary probation
3. Does not meet satisfactory academic progress
4. No longer meets the scholarship qualifications

Applicant Requirements

1. Attach a resume (if applicable)
2. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation with your application. One (1) letter must be from an educational facility
3. Enclose an *official* copy of your student academic record (transcript)
4. Proof of Alaska residency (current PFD notice of approval, current fishing license, or copies of checks written in Alaska for each of the last twelve months are acceptable)

Applicant Procedure

The exact nature and content of the scholarship program will be determined on an annual basis by Laborers' Local 341's Executive Board. Whereas these scholarships are for the members of Local 341 or their dependents, announcement will be made at www.local341.com and a letter will be sent to each applicant that a scholarship is awarded to. The announcements will explain the present annual program available and any specifics involved in applying.

Laborers' Local 341 and the Mano Frey Labor Leadership Scholarship do not discriminate based on race, color, creed, national origin, age or sex in the selection process or the administration of the scholarship program.
