Yearly Reminders

Don't see the training you wanted?

Training programs not listed on this schedule that members need for work must be pre-approved *prior to training* if you want to be reimbursed.

How do I get into an unscheduled class?

Please contact your local union regarding additional classes such as First Aid that are offered on an as needed basis throughout the year.

North Slope Training Course

NSTC is offered monthly in Anchorage & Fairbanks, and is required for work on **the** pipeline. Sign up at your local union for classes. Initial training is 8 hours, yearly renewals as required.

FLAGGER

A certificate is required and must be renewed every 4 years.

Worksite Traffic Supervisor

A certificate is required and must be renewed every 3 years. Check with your local union for details.

Safety & Health

MSHA classes are required for people working at gravel pits. It's two to three days initial training with yearly renewals. People needing an MSHA renewal may also enroll in a full MSHA class and take portions of it for a renewal.

Plumber Utility Certificate

Pipelayers who can verify at least 1000 hours installing water, sewer, or storm lines can apply to take a test with the DOL to gain a Plumber Utility Certificate. It's good for two years and is required for work on private property. Call us to get more information about this certificate and what to study.
